Back in 1914, the concept of Cheese Days originated from the notion that if some little town in Illinois could have a festival commemorating sauerkraut, then a celebration based on the cheese of Green County would be an even better idea. A group of local businessmen planned the event in just nine days, and more than 3,000 people attended the festivities in downtown Monroe.

Since that time, the Green County Cheese Days festival has grown to be a well-loved tradition – held biennially the third weekend in September. Crowds have grown since the early years, and it is estimated that more than 150,000 people will descend upon Monroe’s Historic Courthouse Square over the weekend to polka, yodel, see cheese being made, enjoy Swiss entertainment and live music, tour dairy farms, eat deep fried cheese curds and cream puffs, meet friends new and old, and shop at the Arts & Crafts Show.

The Arts and Crafts Show made its debut at the festival in 1970, and has been a favorite with visitors since that time. We invite you to be a vendor this year at our 21st show.
