- Attend Award Ceremony to be held on Saturday, June 11, 2022 at the Green County Courthouse on the square.
- Receive a certificate of participation and a token gift.
- Receive a special award (Best Costume, Biggest Smile, etc.)
- Have a picture taken with WEDGIE and receive a copy of the photo.
- Opportunity to ride on a float in the Children's Parade.
- Opportunity to ride on a float in The Swiss Colony Cheese Days Parade.

Prince & Princess:

- Attend Orientation Meeting with Royalty Coordinator, King, Queen and Ambassador
- Receive sashes, name tags and festival t-shirts.
- Appear in parades and at special events at the direction of the Royalty Coordinator (dates, times to be determined — based on schedules and availability of prince and princess). ****Parades are during the summer. There are numerous speaking events during the summer and beginning of September that are scheduled outside of school hours.****
- Pose for a photo to be used on Cheese Days billboards.
- Participate in "school rallies" the week of the festival. ****This will require a day off of school on Thursday before Cheese Days.**
- Be introduced on stage during the festival and participate in other events throughout the weekend — including Cow Milking Contest, stirring the cheese kettle. ****The kids are scheduled for appearances all day on Saturday.**
- Lead the Children's Parade on Friday, September 16, 2022.
- Attend the Cheese Days Royalty/VIP Reception (evening of Friday, September 16 @ Turner Hall)
- Ride in The Swiss Colony Cheese Days Parade on Sunday, September 18, 2022.

Prince & Princess Rules & Judging

Rules

- **Contestant Age** – Must be 6 years old by Friday, September 16, 2022, and not older than 12 years old by Sunday, September 18, 2022.
- Must be a Green County resident.
- Must be dressed in a Swiss Costume for the judging. (Please note that the Royalty Coordinator provides oversight in final costume selection and will work with parents to coordinate appropriate outfits and accessories.)
- A parent or guardian **MUST** accompany the child to all events (including judging), as well as provide transportation to and from all events.

Judging

- Judging will take place Saturday, June 11, 2022 at the Historic Green County Courthouse in Downtown Monroe.
- Candidates will be judged on personality, appearance, and speaking ability.
- Candidates will be given a scheduled time for their interview.
- Interviews will be scheduled in alphabetical order. Each child will have a twelve-minute interview, four minutes with each of the three judges.
- Candidates may only be accompanied by parent or guardian to the interview.
- Grandparents, siblings, friends, etc. are invited to attend to the award ceremony.
- The award ceremony will be held Saturday, June 11, 2022 at the Historic Green County Courthouse in Downtown Monroe. Children should be prepared to speak into the microphone and give their name, age, parent's names, and what they like best about the Cheese Days festival.
- All candidates will join together in singing the Cheese Days Song at the awards ceremony. Please have your child practice ahead of time. Go to www.cheesedays.com/festival-history for a recording. Lyrics are below.
